DIRECTIONS

FROM NY: Follow I-84 to exit 1 (Port Jervis). Take Rt. 6W and turn left onto S. Maple (521), just before bridge. [Look for Tri-State sign.] - Camp on right.

FROM PA: Follow 209 to 206S. Cross toll bridge into NJ and make first left onto 521 (River Rd.) Follow 6.5 miles. - Camp is on the left.

Accommodations

Hall Bath:

Comfortable, dormitory style housing located on the 2nd and 3rd floors of the main Inn building. Two single beds and a sink are located in your room with the bathrooms located in the middle of the hall. Linens are provided.

Private bath:

Hotel style lodging on 2nd and 3rd floors of the main Inn building as well as in Taggart Hall. Rooms are furnished with two single beds. Bathrooms are located in your room. Linens are provided.

Dorm Rooms:

Large room with double bed, multiple bunk beds and a private bath. These rooms would accommodate one couple or multiple single people for the weekend. Linens are provided.

Apartment:

One bedroom apartments with separate living room, kitchen, bedroom, and private bath. Linens are provided.

Cottage:

A private bath accommodation with two single beds, located in the heart of the camp, close to everything. There are no stairs to climb which makes these accommodations perfect for those who have difficulty with stairs. Linens are provided.

Hotel:

Because of the limited amount of housing with private baths on grounds, if you are interested, we have made arrangements with the Hampton Inn and Best Western located about 4 miles from our camp in Matamoras, PA. You should make the reservation directly with the hotel. Mention that you are with the group Tri-State Bible Camp, and they will give you a discounted rate. Then just send your registration to us with the **Conference Only** selection circled.
